Fold Line: - - - -

Envelope will fold on - - - - line to finished size. Avoid “front side” white borders by extending full bleed artwork past the fold line to the **Solid — Line**.

Cut Line:

Product will die-cut on this line for fold & glue conversion.

Safe Area:

Keep all important design elements inside the green line.

Outer Bleed Area:

To avoid outer white borders you must extend your artwork past the die-cut line to the orange edge of this template.

Glue Area:

No design/artwork is allowed in this glue application area.

Important!

Don't forget to delete all template elements before submitting files.
